Requirements for a Type Rating Award Course:

1. All applicants must fill out an application.
2. Applicants must be active members in good standing.
3. Applicants must be US Citizens or legal residents.
4. Provide a copy of FAA certificates held.
5. Provide a copy of your FAA records.
6. Applicants must be able read, speak, and write the English language.
7. Applicants must present a satisfactory current Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) knowledge test.
8. Applicants must hold an ATP certificate or a Commercial Pilot certificate with instrument and multi-engine ratings.
9. Applicants must have a minimum of 1500 hours total flight time.
10. Applicants must have a minimum of 500 hours multi-engine flight time.
11. Turbine time preferred.
12. College Degree preferred.
13. If prior military service, applicants must present a copy of form DD214.
14. Applicant must provide a copy of their current DMV record.
15. The HPPA Board of Directors will be the selection board for type rating awards, in compliance with HPPA Bylaws section 30.I.2.
16. Applicants agree, that the information provided to HPPA on the application, is subject to verification by the HPPA.
17. HPPA Officers and BOD members, as well as their family members, will be able to apply for a Type Rating, as part of their membership benefit after self-disclosure. The involved BOD member or officer will not be involved in any capacity in the selection committee, and is excluded from voting in the process.
18. A member will not be awarded more than one Type Rating, during the life of their membership.
